Rexburg Farmers Market to begin June 26

The City of Rexburg will host its first ever farmers market on the evening of Friday, June 26 in the Purrington Plaza parking lot, south of the Rexburg Tabernacle, beginning at 4:00 p.m.. The market was originally planned to be a monthly event in its first year, but based on consumer demand will be a weekly event throughout the summer.

To date, The Rexburg Farmers Market has lined up vendors to sell a variety of locally grown and produced items including produce, plants, kettle corn, baby products, and homemade granola and bread. To date, 15 vendors have signed up to sell at the market, with many additional vendors anticipated.

This will be a great place for families to come together for a fun event with food and entertainment. People will be able to purchase everything from their week's groceries and ready to eat food to home-made products from local artisans as well as baby items.

“We are very excited to participate as a vendor in The Rexburg Farmers Market,” said Shawn Olson, owner of The Rexburg Micro Farms, “I’ve been interested in the local food movement for years. This will be a great chance for people to get to know the faces and people behind the produce and crafts that they already buy; it really draws the community together.”

The City of Rexburg will host weekly farmers markets throughout the summer and early fall. The markets will take place every Friday evening from the last week in June to the last week in September.
