YOUTH GIRLS BASKETBALL

Sign your girls up with the city league to learn the fundamentals of the game and to get experience of being on a team. There is a new Rec/Competitive format this season! If you want to sign up for the rec division, you will need to sign up individually under the rec division. If you want to sign up for the competitive division, it must be signed up as a team through the coach. The divisions will be set up by grade instead of age. For example, a 6GU league is for 6th graders and under. If someone that is in a lower grade wants to play in a higher division, that will be allowed. If a coach wants to register a team, he/she must fill out a team waiver/jersey order then visit the office to register the team in person. 1st, and 2nd grade will have a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 8 players per team and will play the 4 v 4 format on an 8 ft. hoop. 3rd, and 4th grade will have a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 8 players per team and will play the 4 v 4 format on a 9 ft. hoop. 5th & 6th grade will have a minimum of 7 and a maximum of 10 players per team (NO EXCEPTIONS!). 5th and 6th grade will play the 5 v 5 format on 10 ft. hoop. Each participant will receive a team jersey at the first game.

Volunteer coaches are needed !

Grades: 1st-2nd; 3rd-4th; 5th-6th

Cost: Resident \$65; Non-Resident \$70
Team Fee \$65/player on the team (ex. 5 players on the team would cost \$325)

Registration Ends: September 13th (Once the registration deadline has passed, we will continue to take late registrations until the remaining spots are filled)

Dates: The draft for the 12U division will be determined at a later date.

YOUTH BOYS BASKETBALL

Sign your boys up with the city league to learn the fundamentals of the game and to get experience of being on a team. There is a Rec/Competitive format this season. If you want to sign up for the rec division, you will need to sign up individually under the rec division. If you want to sign up for the competitive division, it must be signed up as a team through the coach. The divisions will be set up by grade instead of age. For example, the 7GU league is for 7th graders and under. If someone that is younger wants to play in an older division, that will be allowed. If a coach wants to register a team, he/she must fill out a team waiver/jersey order then visit the office to register the team in person. 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th grade will have a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 8 players per team and will play the 4 v 4 format. 1st and 2nd grade will play on 8ft. hoops, and 3rd and 4th grade will play on 9ft. hoops. 5th, 6th and 7th grade will have a minimum of 7 and a maximum of 10 players per team (NO EXCEPTIONS!). 5th grade and older will play the 5 v 5 format with 10ft. hoops. Each participant will receive a team jersey at the first game.

Volunteer coaches are needed !

Grades: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th-7th

Cost: Resident \$65; Non-Resident: \$70
Team Signup-\$65/player (must call in or visit office to register a team)

Registration Ends: November 27th (Once the registration deadline has passed, we will continue to take late registrations if there are remaining spots available)

Dates: January 13th -March 23rd

Time: Saturdays 9:00am-5:00pm (game time varies)

There will be a draft for the 6th-7th grade division that will be set at a later date and time. (All individual signups will be assigned a team whether they attend the draft or not.)

NORDIC YOUTH SKIING CLUB (7TH-12TH GRADE)

The Nordic Ski Club meets at the Teton Lakes Golf Course, snow or no snow. Kids can take buses from school, and store ski equipment on site. Instructors will teach both classic and skate skiing techniques. This year, sessions will be split up by the following categories: Classic Ski-Beginner; Classic Ski-Intermediate; Skate Ski;. No prior cross-country ski experience necessary, all levels welcome. There is ski equipment (classic) available to rent for the season at a discounted rate.
